BOLLINGEN: A Glimpse into Jung's Inner world



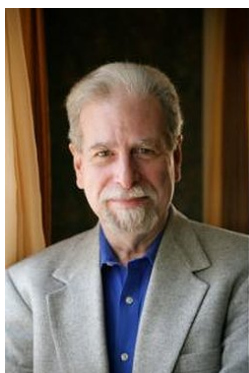

Dr. Erel Shalit is a Jungian psychoanalyst in Tel Aviv. He is a past President of the Israel Society of Analytical Psychology, founding Director of the Jungian Analytical Psychotherapy Program at Bar Ilan University, and past Director of the Shamai Davidson Community Mental Health Clinic, at the Shalvata Psychiatric Centre in Israel.

He is the author of several books *The Cycle of Life: Themes and Tales of the Journey; Enemy, Cripple & Beggar: Shadows in the Hero's Path; The Complex: Path of Transformation from Archetype to Ego; The Hero and His Shadow: Psychopolitical Aspects of Myth and Reality in Israel*, and the novella *Requiem: A Tale of Exile and Return*; and with Nancy Swift Furlotti, he has edited *The Dream and its Amplification*.

He is the editor of *Jacob and Esau: On the Collective Symbolism of the Brother Motif*, a previously unpublished book by Erich Neumann, and *Turbulent Times, Creative Minds - Erich Neumann and C.G. Jung in Relationship*, co-edited with Murray Stein, as well as the author of a forthcoming book on *The Human Soul in Transition, at the Dawn of a New Era*.
